Candidates must have or be willing to gain proficiency with classroom technology support systems such as Transparent Classroom and Google Classroom.

Candidates must hold the minimum of a Bachelor's Degree and a Montessori Lower Elementary credential. The ideal candidate will be highly motivated toward professional development, and able to work successfully and collaboratively in a team approach.
